- Times New Roman Font (size 12)
- Submit electronically as a Microsoft Word document
- Name file after presenting author (example: Smith.docx)

Author Order (see example below)

- List authors by first and last name (example: Jane Smith)
- First author listed is the presenter. Last author is the supervisor/primary investigator.
- Indicate level of training for student presenter.
- Examples: (R5), (Ph.D. Candidate), (Fellow), (Meds 2023)

Oral or Poster

- Indicate in title your preference for **oral** (10 minutes, 5 minutes for questions) or a **poster** presentation.

Proposal

- If you are presenting a study proposal, please indicate this in title. Example: (study proposal)

Study methods: indicate the study location, number of subjects, nonhuman species or material being studied, the principal test(s) performed, and the type(s) of statistical analysis if appropriate.

Results: confirm or refute the hypothesis, supported by statistics, if appropriate.

Conclusion(s): for basic science projects please refer to the clinical significance of the results.
